

There is a full Safeguarding Team at all WCG colleges. Students can speak to any of the team at any time if they have concerns.

Staff at WCG are available to advise and signpost on a wide variety of issues in a non-judgemental and open environment. The team have input into tutorials on relevant health and wellbeing topics. The Mental Health Support Team and college counsellors support students and the college nurse is available to residential students.

STUDENT ACCOMMODATION

We offer on-site student accommodation at three of our colleges; **Royal Leamington Spa**, **Moreton Morrell** and **Pershore**. A residential bursary can help those eligible with the cost of accommodation and a range of packages are available.

LEARNING SUPPORT

The Academic Learning Support team are qualified teachers who are either maths or English specialists and provide help with essay writing, maths, English skills and more at all colleges. Support is flexible and can be arranged to fit in around student timetables. We also offer 'drop in' sessions for all students at lunchtimes.

INCLUSION

Our Inclusion Team will support you if you have specific learning needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP). Specialist support is available for learners with dyslexia, ASD (autism spectrum disorder), hearing or visual impairment, physical needs and emotional needs. The team provide Access Arrangements for examinations and assistive technology to support independent learning.

They provide support to learners transitioning from school and offer a Preparation for Adulthood package. Learners' needs are looked at on an individual basis and support is put in place to help students be successful on their course. 





T-LEVELS

T levels are a new qualification designed to give you a head start towards the future you want. The 2-year T Level qualification brings classroom and work placement together on a course designed alongside employers and businesses.

Your T Level will help you to your next step - whether this is straight into your chosen career, an apprenticeship or a degree.

T Levels give you the opportunity to experience an industry while you continue your studies, with the opportunity to specialise later. While gaining practical experience, you also achieve the qualifications needed to move into a higher level of study, if you choose to later.


HOW ARE T LEVELS GRADED?

To help T Level students get into higher education, UCAS tariff points have been allocated to T Levels, which means they will be equivalent to three A Levels. UCAS points will only be allocated to the overall T Level grade, so you must achieve at least an overall pass grade to receive UCAS points.

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





If you love to play football and are looking for an opportunity to combine playing with your studies, then our Academy may be just right for you!

We were granted degree awarding powers in 2021, which means that we can now design and award our own full three-year Honours degrees, as well as continuing to award our own Foundation degrees.

We have been running higher education programmes for over 30 years at **Warwickshire College and University Centre (WCUC)** and these powers are awarded following a rigorous assessment process spanning several months.

We pride ourselves on offering qualifications and apprenticeships aligned to key industries and jobs, and we can now apply this to our own degree courses by ensuring all of our degrees have a technical or professional focus. This means that many students who begin a course with us after leaving school at 16 now have the option to stay at college and progress on to a full three-year Honours degree.


