## FEES & FUNDING

Where fees apply, you will see a fee code listed in the fee code column for each course as follows:

- A:** This is the full fee which must be **paid by all learners**; no fee remission or waivers are available.
- B:** This is the fee rate for **learners who are 19+** and have been **citizens of a country within the EEA for a minimum of three years**. Funding will be available once per academic year, per learner, for the subject studied.
- C:** The courses may be either **FREE or a REDUCED fee for learners who are 19+ (depending on their circumstances) and who have been citizens of a country within the EEA for a minimum of three years**. Circumstances taken into consideration could include: age, benefits, employment status, income and prior qualifications.  
**Please call 0330 135 6780 to determine the fee you would pay.**
- D:** Learners are **eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan** (full or partial) for courses at Level 3 to 4 if they:
- Hold a **full Level 3 qualification** and are **aged between 19–23** on the first day of your course
  - **Are aged 24 and above** on the first day of your course. Alternatively, dependent on circumstances, a waiver may be applicable.

Access to HE learners from WCG have gained entry to universities across the region and beyond, including Warwick, Coventry, Worcester, Aston, Birmingham, Birmingham City University, Wolverhampton, Northampton and Gloucestershire.

## THINKING OF STARTING AN ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION COURSE THIS YEAR?

If you're aged 19 or over, then the **Advanced Learner Loan** can help you to gain a **Level 3 to 6 qualification\*** with **nothing to pay upfront and you don't pay anything back until you are earning over £25,000 a year**.

It's easy to apply for, there are **no credit checks** and your eligibility doesn't depend upon your household income.

**Plus...** if you take out an Advanced Learner Loan for an Access to HE diploma and you progress to complete a higher education course, **the loan is written off!**

\*If you are aged 19-23 and the Access course is your first full Level 3, then you will be eligible for FREE tuition and you will not need to pay a fee or take out an Advanced Learner Loan.
